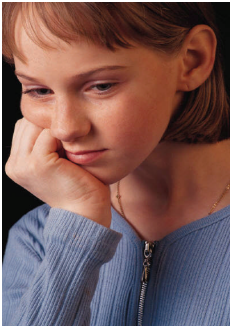

### Battering Intervention and Prevention Program ( BIPP)

BIPP consist of group educational programs for family violence offenders, in which offenders are held accountable for past abusive behavior and taught the fundamentals of leading a non-violent lifestyle.

## **Battering Intervention and Prevention Program ( BIPP)**

Kinghaven Counseling Group Battering Intervention and Prevention Program (BIPP) provides services to men and women who have been violent, abusive, and/or controlling in their intimate and family relationships to recognize, accept responsibility for, and end this behavior. There are four phases to BIPP:

**1. REGISTER:** Individuals are required to call the KCG office between 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday to **register** themselves for program services and schedule an evaluation appointment.

**2. EVALUATION:** The first face-to-face service is the evaluation. The facilitator conducts a psycho-social evaluation. The primary purpose of this session is to evaluate the potential client's ability to participate and progress appropriately in a group setting.

**3. ORIENTATION:** Which is conducted in an interactive group format in order to help prepare the client for the group experience.

**4. GROUP SESSION:** After completing evaluation and orientation sessions, participants enter an on-going Group. All groups are conducted per State BIPP Guidelines.
